



PROCLAMATION

Arbor Day

March 6, 2012

WHEREAS, Arbor Day Observances were held in California during the week of March 6th, 2012, and in the City of Santa Barbara throughout the month of March; and

WHEREAS, the City of Santa Barbara has been designated a "Tree City USA" for 32 years by the National Arbor Day Foundation; and

WHEREAS, the City of Santa Barbara is proud of its approximately 40,000 public open space, park, and street trees and recognizes the importance of professional tree care and annual tree planting programs that create a more livable community; and

WHEREAS, Arbor Day observances were held at seven (7) local grade school campuses; and

WHEREAS, this spring, Santa Barbara is celebrating 110 years of City Parks, providing stewardship of trees, parks, and open space; and

WHEREAS, the City acknowledges Santa Barbara Beautiful's significant contribution to our urban forest through the planting of over 12,000 street trees in the past 46 years.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, HELENE SCHNEIDER, by virtue of the authority invested in me as Mayor of the City of Santa Barbara, California, do hereby acknowledge and proclaim March 6, 2012, as **ARBOR DAY** in the City of Santa Barbara and recognize the value that trees provide in enhancing the quality of our lives.
