**SUBJECT:** Authorization For The Allocation Of Transportation Development Act Funds

### RECOMMENDATION:

That Council adopt, by reading of title only, A Resolution of the Council of the City of Santa Barbara Authorizing the Filing of a Claim with the Santa Barbara County Association of Governments for Allocation of \$69,742 in Transportation Development Act Funds for Fiscal Year 2015.

### DISCUSSION:

Each year, the City is required to adopt a resolution authorizing the Public Works Director to file a claim for the City's share of area-wide Transportation Development Act Funds. The use of these funds is restricted to pedestrian and bicycle projects.

The claim that will be submitted to the Santa Barbara County Association of Governments for Fiscal Year 2015 includes \$69,742 for pedestrian and bicycle facilities. The funds are available based on a formula previously agreed to by the County of Santa Barbara and the cities within the County. Staff will use this money for bicycle and pedestrian projects, and as matching dollars when competing for state and federal bicycle and pedestrian grants.
