

  - Day Shift Patrol Officers are Conducting Downtown Foot Patrol During the Early Morning Hours
  - Tactical Patrol Force is Currently Working 9:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. to Address Evening Issues Downtown
  - In the Absence of the Nightlife Enforcement Team, Grant Funds are Being Used to Staff Alcohol Related Directed Patrols
    - *Targeting Underage Drinking, False ID's & DUI*

# Patrol Division

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- Restorative Policing
  - Current Unit Staffing is 1 Officer & 2 Civilian Outreach Specialists
    - *Oversee 122 Clients in Restorative Court & Veterans Treatment Court*
  - Recent Successes
    - *Reunification of a 42-year old man who had accumulated 24 criminal charges. He had served a prison sentence, was homeless upon release, and became a victim violent crime. Restorative Policing helped him return home to Oklahoma where he will participate in a residential treatment program.*

# Patrol Division

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- Restorative Policing
  - Recent Successes, Continued
    - *Reunification of a 31-year old Army combat veteran who was homeless since his discharge in 2010. He was suffering from mental health and violence issues. He had accumulated 4 criminal charges. Restorative Policing facilitated reunification with his family in Texas.*
    - *Placement of a 59-year old parolee into a shelter facility. This client was frequently contacted by police in the Downtown Corridor. Restorative Policing assisted him with placement into a medical bed at the Casa Esperanza / PATH Shelter.*

# Investigative Division

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- Significant Events, Continued
  - Daniel Rico Fabien Prosecution
    - *Arrested for the October 31, 2015 Rape of a Homeless Woman*
    - *Also Charged in Santa Barbara for the 2014 Rape of a Homeless Woman in LA County*
    - *Pled Guilty Prior to Trial & Sentenced to 32 Years in Prison*

# Investigative Division

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- Significant Events, Continued
  - Kelly Hunt Gang Execution Convictions
    - *Isaac Jimenez Sentenced to Life without the Possibility of Parole*
      - He also Pled No Contest to a Gang Related Shooting on Kowalski Street Two Weeks Prior
    - *Joseph Castro will also be Sentenced Next Month for the Murder of Kelly Hunt*


# Investigative Division

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- Investigative Division Staffing
  - The Investigative Division is Normally Comprised of 18 Detectives, 4 Sergeants & 1 Lab Technician
    - *5 Detective Positions are Currently Being Kept Vacant to Assist with Patrol Team Staffing*
    - *2 Detectives are on IOD Status, 1 Detective is on Modified Duty*
    - *No Detective Assigned to the Narcotics Task Force*
      - We Continue to Share Resources with the Sheriff's Office & Narcotics Task Force Countywide
  - New Crime Lab Technician Started Yesterday
    - *Since November We had been Working with the Sheriff's Office to Process Evidence*


UCR Part 1 Reported Crimes Calendar Years 1984 thru 2014






Total Violent Crime Yearly Total

Total Violent Crime YTD 2009-2016




Total Violent Crime by Month 2012-2016






Total Property Crime Yearly Total
