**SUBJECT:** Adoption of Oversized Vehicle Parking Ordinance

### **RECOMMENDATION:**

That Council adopt, by reading of title only, An Ordinance of the Council of the City of Santa Barbara Amending the Santa Barbara Municipal Code by Adding Section 10.44.220 With Respect to Oversized Vehicle Parking, Amending Section 10.44.200 to Eliminate the Term "Temporary Recreational Vehicle," and Repealing Section 10.44.205 Pertaining to Recreational Vehicle Parking.

### **DISCUSSION:**

Council introduced the Oversized Vehicle Parking Ordinance on October 18, 2016, including minor changes to the financial findings to conform them to updated information from the Community Development Department Housing and Human Services Division. Those changes are reflected in Section 1.F.

The Ordinance will be effective beginning on December 16, 2016. Enforcement will not begin until adequate sign posting is completed, however. Public Works Transportation staff expect delivery of the requisite 276 or so signs before the end of the year, with installation expected to be complete by March 2017. This process will also involve the removal of more than 400 existing "No RV" parking signs, as SBMC 10.44.205 is being repealed.

Public Works Transportation staff are also developing the online temporary and disability parking permit processes. The progress details on this work will be posted to a City webpage, along with FAQs and other important information. Finally, staff intends to use windshield flyers to inform and notify oversized vehicle operators of the new law.
