**SUBJECT:** Authorization For The Allocation Of The City's Share Of Transportation Development Act Funds For Bicycle And Pedestrian Projects

### **RECOMMENDATION:**

That Council adopt, by reading of title only, A Resolution of the Council of the City of Santa Barbara Authorizing the Filing of a Claim with the Santa Barbara County Association of Governments for Allocation of \$74,775 in Transportation Development Act Funds for Fiscal Year 2018.

### **DISCUSSION:**

Each year, the City is required to adopt a resolution authorizing the Transportation Manager to file a claim for the City's share of area-wide Transportation Development Act funds. The use of these funds is restricted to pedestrian and bicycle projects.

The claim that will be submitted to the Santa Barbara County Association of Governments for Fiscal Year 2018, includes \$74,775 for pedestrian and bicycle facilities. The funds are available based on a formula previously agreed to by the County of Santa Barbara and the cities within the County. Staff will be using this money to initiate the Sola, Alisos, and Chino Bike Boulevards, as well as the Cota, Ortega, and Rancheria bike lanes as a part of the Active Transportation Grants that the City was awarded for these projects. The initial work will include striping and design work. A portion of the money may also be needed to support the Old Coast Sidewalk Infill project, which was also an Active Transportation Grant.
