

ORDINANCE NO. 5432

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SANTA BARBARA APPROVING A POWER PURCHASE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF SANTA BARBARA AND TIOGA ENERGY, INC., OR SOLAR POWER PARTNERS FUND I, LLC, FOR THE DESIGN, CONSTRUCTION, OWNERSHIP, MAINTENANCE AND OPERATION OF A SOLAR ELECTRICAL SYSTEM AT 630 GARDEN STREET AND 635 LAGUNA STREET, SANTA BARBARA, CALIFORNIA, AND RELATED INCENTIVE PROGRAM AGREEMENTS WITH SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA EDISON COMPANY

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SANTA BARBARA DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. In accordance with the provisions of Section 521 of the Charter of the City of Santa Barbara, a power purchase agreement and ancillary agreements as required between the City of Santa Barbara and Tioga Energy Inc., or Solar Power Partners Fund I, LLC, for the design, construction, ownership, maintenance, and operation of a solar electrical system at 630 Garden Street and 635 Laguna Street, Santa Barbara, California, for a period of twenty-one (21) years, beginning on September 30, 2007, and ending no later than September 29, 2028, and related program agreements with Southern California Edison Company providing for participation in solar energy incentive programs administered by said company are hereby approved.
