### *Harbor and Seafood Festival Week* *October 8-14, 2007*

*WHEREAS, the Santa Barbara Channel offers a rich maritime history and Santa Barbara Harbor is home to many ocean-related businesses and activities, including commercial fishing; and*

*WHEREAS, an annual, free-admission Festival acknowledging Santa Barbara Harbor's contribution to the community has become an honored tradition; and*

*WHEREAS, a Harbor and Seafood Festival benefiting the Page Youth Center will take place from 10:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. at Santa Barbara Harbor on Saturday, October 13, 2007; and*

*WHEREAS, the Festival will feature an albacore barbeque, boiled crab and lobster boil, marine exhibits, marine information booths, live music, arts and crafts, raffles, children's activities, boat rides, tours of a NOAA research vessel and a Coast Guard vessel, seafood cooking demonstrations and a daylong Fishermen's Market; and*

*WHEREAS, participation by the Santa Barbara Maritime Museum will include free admission to the museum, guided museum tours, maritime films, a treasure-map activity, and maritime crafts;*
