SUBJECT: Appointment Of Mayor Pro Tempore, Ordinance Committee, Finance Committee, And Liaisons To Advisory Boards And Commissions

RECOMMENDATION:

That Council consider the appointment of a Mayor Pro Tempore, Chairs and Members of the Ordinance and Finance Committees, and Liaisons to Advisory Boards and Commissions.

DISCUSSION:

Designation of Mayor Pro Tempore - Section 504 of the Charter says that "The City Council shall designate one (1) of its members as Mayor Pro Tempore, who shall serve in such capacity at the pleasure of the City Council." Council Member Das Williams presently holds the position.

Appointment of Ordinance Committee - Resolution No. 94-129, adopted on October 11, 1994, provides for the appointment of a three (3) member Ordinance Committee and the designation of the Chair of said Committee to serve for one year. Also, Resolution No. 99-034 providing for the appointment of the Mayor as an alternate member was adopted on May 4, 1999. The current membership of this committee is as follows:
