

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
SANTA BARBARA FOR EMPLOYER-PAID MEMBER
CONTRIBUTIONS FOR HOURLY EMPLOYEES
EFFECTIVE JUNE 19, 2010

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Santa Barbara has the authority to implement Government Code Section 20691;

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Santa Barbara has a written labor policy or agreement which specifically provides for the normal member contributions paid by the employer and reported as additional compensation to be decreased to 1.327% in fiscal year 2011 based on a formula related to the reported employer rate for the 2010-2011 fiscal year;

WHEREAS, one of the steps in the procedures to implement Section 20691 is the adoption by the Council of the City of Santa Barbara of a Resolution to commence said Employer Paid Member Contributions (EPMC);

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Santa Barbara has identified the following conditions for the purpose of its election to pay EPMC:

- This benefit change shall apply to all Hourly Employees in the PERS Miscellaneous Plan;
- This benefit shall consist of paying the decreased amount of 1.327 % of the normal 8% member contributions as EPMC, and reporting the same percent (value) of compensation earnable {excluding Government Code Section 20636(c)(4)} as additional compensation; and
- The effective date of this Resolution shall be June 19, 2010.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of the City of Santa Barbara elects to pay EPMC, as set forth above. This Resolution will supersede similar provisions previously adopted by Resolution that provided for the City to pay 1.343% of the member contribution.
