**WHEREAS**, Family Service Agency will operate 2-1-1 Santa Barbara County as the umbrella agency. Family Service Agency's mission is to strengthen and advocate for families and individuals of all ages and diversities, helping to create and preserve a healthy community.

**NOW THEREFORE, I, HELENE SCHNEIDER**, by virtue of the authority vested in me as Mayor of the City of Santa Barbara, California, do hereby proclaim February 11<sup>th</sup>, 2011, as **National 2-1-1 Awareness Day** in Santa Barbara, and encourage citizens to learn more about 2-1-1 Santa Barbara County and the resources it provides to thousands in our community!
