## Dear Camp Rad Junior Counselors,

### Welcome!

We are very excited about our upcoming summer season and look forward to meeting our new Junior Counselors. We have tried to include as many exciting activities as we could squeeze into a six-hour day. This is a traveling camp, which will spend the majority of the day traveling to different locations and participating in different activities. All activities have been pre-scheduled and will be directly supervised by Natalie and Juan, who will be co-directing the program after directing and working with the Parks and Recreation Department Sports and Beach Camp and Camp Rad. In addition to Natalie and Juan, each activity will be directed or instructed by professional staff, and when visiting aquatic environments there will always be a certified beach lifeguard or service on duty.

**Please read through all of the following information carefully:**

### First Day of Camp

We do not require a standalone Junior Counselor training meeting for this program.

Instead, please **arrive at 8:30am at the Cabrillo Bathhouse (Beach Level) for a camp specific orientation.** The Bathhouse is located at 1118 E. Cabrillo Blvd, Santa Barbara, CA 93103. You will be provided with a camp shirt to wear during the program.

### Daily Camp Requirements

- Report each day no later than 8:45 a.m.
- We look forward to working with you, as you will be an important part of our staff.
- Please be respectful and professional to staff members. Remember that safety is our first priority when interacting with the campers. This experience gives you the opportunity to earn community service hours as well as job experience and future references.
- If you are sick or unable to make it to camp please let us know in advance or call the Bathhouse at (805) 897-2680 and leave a message that they will pass on to us.

### Liability Waivers

This camp will be doing several activities that require separate liability waivers to be completed by parents and turned in on the first day of the program; those activities are the Sky High Sports, Santa Barbara Climbing wall, MB2 Raceway, and Standup Paddling. The waivers are included in this packet, and if we do not receive them by the first day of the program, you will be unable to participate in these activities.

### Activity Calendars

The Parks and Recreation Department's aquatics team is providing activity calendars to assist with any required preparation for each day's listed activities, and for reference. Staff members do their very best to adhere to the



distributed calendar, but activities are subject to change based on decisions regarding the environment, safety or other conditions related to camper needs.

Due to the size of the camp and the limited space in the Parks and Recreation vans we will not have room to permit parents or other guests to accompany the camp on excursions or daily activities.
