Restorative Court Two Year Up-date

- ◆ **171 Clients Processed Through Restorative Court**
- ◆ **38 Were on the Common Ground Vulnerability Index**
- ◆ **52 Graduated the program after 6 months of no new arrests or citations**
- ◆ **119 Program Placements (19 placed multiple times due to incompatibilities)**
- ◆ **25 Housed**

These 171 clients were responsible for over 6000 calls for service from the Police Department prior to their involvement with Restorative Court.
